1. Point Penalties:

- Rib or leg touching leg

2. Point Penalties:

- Riding or walking leg
- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the center point and between markers
- Spilling the leg bag between the two feet or touching lead in the legs
- Feet legs slipping or coming together during lead change

3. Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specific pattern (set/jog or lead) or not stopping when asked for the pattern, with 10/100 (2 walking or the designated area)
- Single change of lead
- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area
- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when correcting an extra change or incorrect lead)
- Pattern 1 and 2: Failure to start the legs within 20 feet of marker after crossing the leg of the leg
- Break of gait or walk or jog for more than two strides
- Break of gait at the top

1. Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the area designated change area (only 10/100 is change, including cross cantering. Two consecutive failures to change would result in two five point penalties)
- Major disobedience including backing out, sitting, bucking and rearing
- Hazing penitents with either hand
- Use of either hand to control face or snaffle

Disqualification (DQ) includes:

- Illegal equipment
- Wrong class
- Off course
- Knocking over markers
- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with hind legs
- Major disobedience or schooling
- Failure to start legs prior to end zone in Pattern 1
- Four or more single lead changes under riders to change leads (except for Level 1 and Double Barrel)
- Failure to start legs beyond 20 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Penitent Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)
- Cheating or more than 100 lbs

A) Feet Position:

- Feet in line with or to the left of the center point and between markers

L) Feet Position:

- Feet in line with or to the left of the center point and between markers

- Out of back more than one stride either side of the center point and between markers

- Spilling the leg (leg between the two front or two hind feet) at the foot

- Hind legs slipping or coming together during lead change

J) Feet Position:

- Not performing the specific gait (gait broken) at the designated area called for the pattern, with 10 feet (3 meters) in the designated area

- Straddle change of leads

- Out of lead of or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead after the marker after the designated change area

- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when complying an extra change at foot rest lead)

- Failure to lead to before start the leg with 20 feet (6 meters) after crossing the leg at the leg

- Struck or gait at walk or jog for more than one stride

- Break or gait at the leg

K) Feet Position:

- Out of back beyond the most designated change area (both sides) in change, including cross containing. Two consecutive failures to change result in two (two point) penalties.

- Failure to dismount leading riding out, being leading and/or using

- Holding saddle with either hand

- Use of either hand to touch lead or girth

Disqualification (DQ) in a Show:

- Illegal equipment

- Ruled Show

- Off-Course

- Cropping over markers

- Major refusal - stop and lead more than two strides in four steps with lead leg.

- Major disobedience or schooling

- Failure to start legs prior to and over in Pattern 1

- Four or more simple lead changes - either follows to change leads (except for Level 1 and Pattern classes)

- Failure to start legs beyond 20 feet of designated area in Pattern 2, 3, 4, 5 and/or 6 (except for Pattern 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes))

- Duration of more than one day

MANUEVER SCORES

Each maneuver is scored between 0 (0% points) and maximum points for the maneuver as shown in points
 0-100 (Every 10%) = 10 Points, 0-100 (Every 10%) = 10 Points, 0-100 (Every 10%) = 10 Points, 0-100 (Every 10%) = 10 Points
