- **If you don't let me know by 12:00pm (noon) on Wednesday, the week of the show, you will be charged for the stalls. If we rent the stalls out again you will still be charged.**
- **If you show a horse in walk trot pattern class, you can not show the same horse in lope.**

You are able to bring your own shavings to the HCHA Show. We are requiring all dogs on a leashes for the safety of the dogs and people.

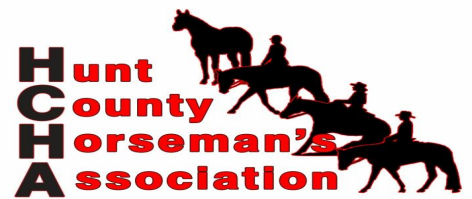
